

Official School Detention

Thursday detention can only be given by your form teacher, Head of Year, Head of Key Stage or a member of the Senior Management Team.

Classroom issues will be dealt with by your subject teacher eg lunchtime/break-time/afterschool detention. These detentions will be recorded on SIMS.

If a problem persists, it should then be referred to your form teacher who needs to be given evidence of the action taken by your teacher. If your form teacher puts you in detention, then it will be recorded on SIMS.

Thursday detention is from 3.25 – 4.30 PM and doing homework during this time will not be allowed. You will be given work which is educational and constructive.

The Office staff post letters on Tuesday for Thursday detention therefore any detention issued on or after Tuesday will go into detention on Thursday of the following week.

If you are placed on detention you should report to the Library each week and you may then be taken to another classroom by the supervising teacher.

If you either (1) fail to turn up or (2) are persistently in Thursday detention you will be referred to your Head of Year or Head of Key Stage where you will be put into Friday detention (3.30 – 4.30 PM)

Friday detention can only be given by Head of Year, Head of Key Stage or a member of the Senior Management Team.

If you miss a Friday detention or are persistently in Friday detention, then you will be referred to the Senior Management Team
